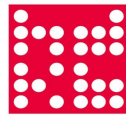
Alexander von Humboldt Institute for Internet and Society (HIIG)

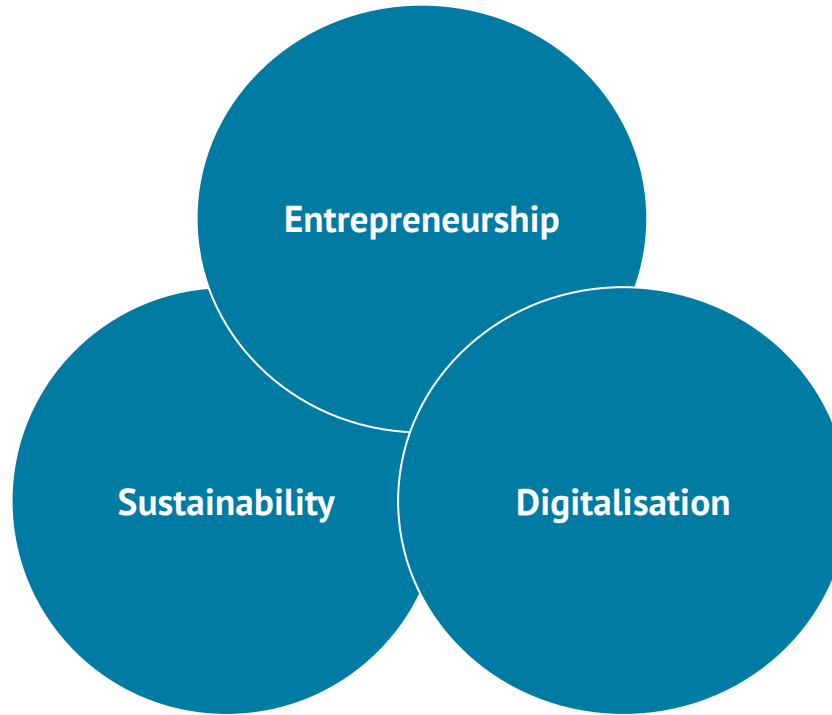

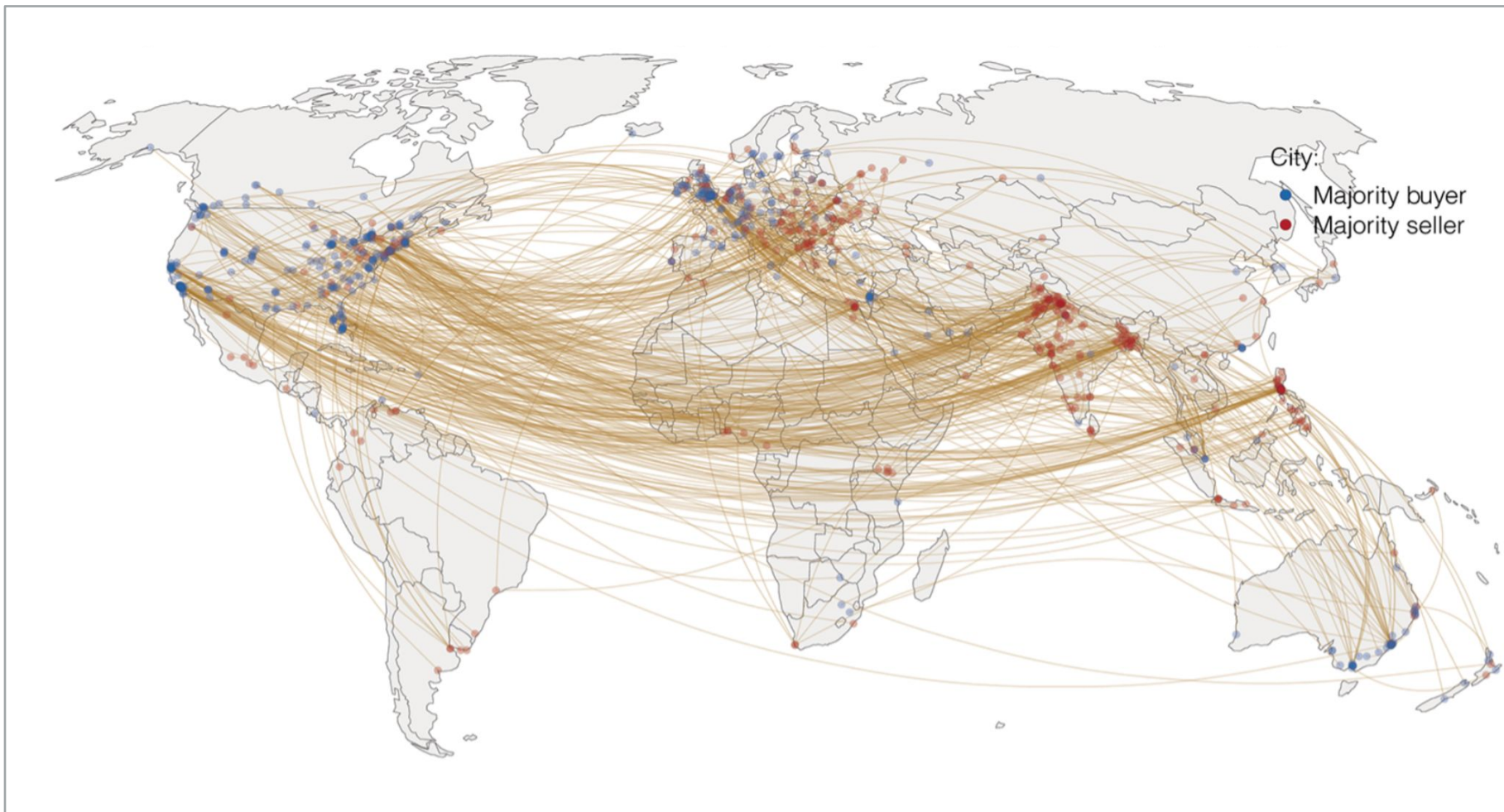
